At the conclusion of the *T3*, your center will be eligible to apply for educational grants from the *Parents Empowering Parents* (PEP) program to reduce barriers to implementation of PEP in your local area. ** It is **mandatory that parents wishing to become PEP trainers attend and complete a local PEP program prior to attending the T3** and parents must be referred by a professional social worker or nurse from his/her HTC or Chapter. The *T3* is a training and does not take participants through the entire PEP course.
